Sealed bids for the construction of Contract No. 7 for the Clinton CSO Storage Facility Project will be received by the Director, Onondaga County Division of Purchase, 13th Floor Civic Center, 421 Montgomery Street, Syracuse, NY 13202, until 2:00 P.M. Local Time, on June 23, 2011, and there at said office, at said time, publicly opened and read aloud.

This project is located in the parking area along Onondaga Creek behind the elevated rail tracks off of West Jefferson Street. The project generally consists of the construction of a 6 million gallon combined sewer overflow (CSO) storage facility. The storage facility will consist of three parallel tunnels connected with entrance shafts at each end. There will be above ground builds at each entrance shaft that will provide access and servicing of the tunnels. The facility will have dewatering pumps, effluent pumps, bridge crane and clam shell, 84-inch diameter West Jefferson CSO transmission conveyance, 36-inch diameter West Street CSO transmission conveyance, 96-inch diameter West Onondaga Street CSO transmission conveyance, 16-inch diameter dewatering force mains, 12-inch sewer main relocation and all associated piping, valves, electrical, instrumentation, HVAC, plumbing, and associated appurtenances. The project also includes the restoration of the parking lot and appurtenances.

The Contract Documents, including Information for Bidders and Bid Forms may be obtained from Environmental Engineering Associates, LLP (EEA), One Remington Park Drive, Cazenovia, NY 13035 upon deposit of \$100.00 per set (checks only, **made payable to County of Onondaga**). Requests for Contract Documents to be sent via standard U.S. mail must be accompanied by a separate non-refundable \$15.00 check (**made payable to Environmental Engineering Associates, LLP**) to cover postage. Requests for Contract Documents to be sent via express shipping must be accompanied by the recipient's Federal Express or UPS account number. Drawings are available in full or half size, the Bidder must specify the drawing size when requesting documents. The full amount of the deposit for sets of Contract Documents will be refunded to all holders of the Contract Documents who return their Contract Documents complete and in good condition within thirty days following award of the Contract or rejection of the bids.

Each bid must be accompanied by cash, certified check, or bid bond in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid in the form and subject to the conditions provided in the Information For Bidders. In addition, the Contractor shall be required to provide a "Statement of Surety's Intent" with his bid.

The Bidders should not include in their bid the Sales and Compensating Use Taxes on the cost of the materials which are to be incorporated into the Project and which are to be separately sold by the Bidder to the municipality prior to incorporation into the Project.

The right is reserved to waive any informalities in the Bid and to reject any or all bids.
